MANUSCRIPT TITLE

ABSTRACT

A short Abstract should summarize the main points and reflect the content of the article. It should be written in a clear and concise way. Abbreviations used in the main text may be introduced and used. Use neither bibliographic references nor references to figures or tables in the Abstract.

Count of abstracts: 2,000–8,000 characters with spaces.

Keywords: *Please provide 3–5 keywords highlighting the most important points of the paper.*

MAIN TEXT of RESEARCH ARTICLE

Research Articles report on primary research. They must describe significant and original observations. Consideration for publication is based on the article's originality, novelty, and scientific soundness, and the appropriateness of its analysis. Research Articles are reports of original work. It is recommended to structure it using the following subheadings: Introduction, Methods, Research, Results, Discussion and Conclusion.

Text should be uploaded in DOC, DOCX or RTF file format. Count of article: up to 50,000 characters (with spaces). Languages: English, Ukrainian, Polish. Font: Times New Roman, font size: 12 pt, line spacing: 1,5.

REFERENCES AND SOURCES

References in the text should be identified sequentially using [Chicago Style \(Notes and Bibliography\)](#) or [ДСТУ 8302:2015](#) (Ukrainian style). List of abbreviations may be included if needed.

MAIN TEXT of the RESEARCH ARTICLE

Figures (up to 20 figures) should be uploaded as separate items in JPG or TIF file format with a resolution of not less than 300 dpi and size to fit the page (preferably at least 10x15 cm at 300 dpi). All figures have to be numbered. Figures should be mentioned in the manuscript text at the right place as follows: (Fig. 1). Captions to illustrations provided in a separate file.
